

SONG CHOOSING BOARDS

Aim: For child to request a song during a small/large group activity by choosing the picture that represents that song.

How to set it up:

1. Create pictures to represent the songs you use. You could use the internet, draw them or cut them out of catalogues.
2. Laminate and cut out symbols/drawings for songs. Ensure the song's name is written on each card.
3. Laminate a large piece of cardboard with "Songs We Sing" written on it.
4. Attach Velcro or blue tack to each of the song cards. Stick between 2 and 6 song cards onto song choosing board.

How to use it:

- At the start of singing session tell the children what songs they are going to be singing pointing to each of the song symbol cards.
- Ask a child to choose a song by taking it off the board. Encourage them to name the song. If they don't name it model the name of the song.
- Keep selecting a child to choose a song until all the songs are removed from the board.
